Recipe

Hook:	Mustad Dry Fly Size:10-16
Thread:	Black, 6/0
Tail:	Golden Pheasant Tippet, two strands.
Wings:	Grizzly Hackle Tips, tied semi-spent, advanced forward.
Body:	Gray Wool Yarn
Hackle:	Grizzly & Brown, mixed.

Tying Tips: Standard techniques.

Fishing Tips: A good general purpose fly, productive in most situations. Commonly fished as a caddis imitation.

Historical Note: This fly was created by Leonard Halladay for Mr. Charles Adams in the summer of 1922. Mr. Halladay often spoke of the recipe for his pattern. The pattern information is historically correct.
