

# Bell's Hexagenia



## Recipe

Hook: Mustad #9672 3XL    Size: 6-8  
Thread: Brown, 6/0  
Tail: Pheasant Tail Fibers, 3 to 5  
Body: Pale Yellow Wool  
Wing: Calftail, split delta-wing style  
Hackle: Brown, 3 hackles, tied very heavy

*Tying Tips:* Standard techniques. Leave lots of room for the wing and the three hackles. Wing(s) should extend to the end of the tail. I'm told that this fly can also be tied parachute.

*Fishing Tips:* Used for the hex hatch. This fly combines all the necessary characteristics of the perfect hex fly. The silhouette is right, it floats and it's visible. Fished on the surface or just under the surface.

*Historical Note:* This fly was created by Mr. Jim Bell of Muskegon in the late 1980s.
