

Cabin Coachman



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #94840 Size: 10-14
Thread:	Brown, 6/0
Tail:	Brown Hackle Fibers
Wings:	Mallard Flank, upright & divided.
Body:	Peacock Herl
Hackle:	Brown

Tying Tips: May be tied with Red Hackle Fibers for the tail.

Fishing Tips: An excellent general purpose attractor pattern.

Historical Note: Originally tied by Aggie Bugby of Grayling, Michigan, most probably in the late 1930's or early 40's. This pattern is not to be confused with the Cabin Coachman pattern created by John Stephan and George Mason.
