

Catau's Little Yellow Stone Fly

Recipe



Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 14-16
Thread: Yellow, 6/0
Body: Yellow Polypropylene or Dubbing
Wing: Wood Duck Flank, tied trude, extend
just slightly beyond the bend o the
hook.
Hackle: Brown, two hackles, tied heavy
Head: Yellow thread

Tying Tips: Standard techniques, not hard to tie at all. I used Fly Rite Poly #4. Body color can be varied depending on the flies in your area. It can also be tied down to a size #20.

Fishing Tips: Used during mid summer to late fall in the late afternoon for 'candata' stone fly hatches.

Historical Note: Dan Catau developed this pattern back in the 1960s. He's a retired Michigan tier who tied for over 40 years. He's tied flies for such personalities as William Conrad and Jack Nicklaus. Dan is an established author and has had several TV appearances.
