

Cedar Creek Hex Spinner



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #94831	Size: 4-6
Thread:	Brown, 6/0	
Tail:	Two Moose Mane Fibers, dyed yellowish-brown	
Wing:	White Calftail, tied upright and divided.	
Body:	Deer Body Hair, dyed yellowish-brown	
Egg Sac:	Golden Olive Poly, Fly-Rite #8	
Rib:	Brown Thread, crisscrossed	
Hackle:	Grizzly Hackle, dyed yellowish-tan	

Tying Tips: I prefer a Mustad #94840 or #94833. You may use the tips from the extended deer hair body for the two tail fibers --- simply trim away all but two. Tail fibers should be in a V pattern. Please note that the body hairs are not flared at the tail. Egg Sac is optional. The deer hair body may be substituted with Golden Olive Poly Dubbing.

Fishing Tips: Designed to represent female *Hexagenia*. A very productive pattern.

Historical Note: Created by Jim Kane from Michigan probably in the mid 1970's or 1980's.
