

Chuck Wing Bee



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #94840 or #94833	Sizes: 12-16
Thread:	Yellow, 6/0	
Body:	Yellow Deer Body Hair, tied parallel to the shank of the hook --- so that the tips extend beyond the bend.	
Tail:	Flared Deer Body Hair that was extended from the body.	
Rib:	Black Floss, 4-5 turns.	
Wing:	Woodchuck, tied down, trude style.	
Hackle:	Furnace	

Tying Tips: Tail should not extend beyond the length of the hook. Floss is delicate, you may want to lacquer the fly

Fishing Tips: It's a searching or attractor pattern to be used during the summer months when the fish are not taking anything else.

Historical Note: This fly is one of a series of bee flies that were designed by Tom Deschaine, a retired school teacher in Westland, Michigan. It was designed in 2007. Tom is a fly tier and custom rod builder.
