

Deer Hair Drake



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 14 XL
Thread: Black, 8/0
Tail: Pheasant Tail Fibers, tied in a 'V'
Wing: White Deer Hair, tied clump style
Body: Tan Deer Hair, tied parallel to the hook, flared at the tail.
Rib: Black thread, tied crisscross
Hackle: Grizzly

Tying Tips: Standard techniques. Tied drake style. The fly may be tied in different sizes.

Fishing Tips: A generalized attractor pattern that can be used most any time.

Historical Note: This fly was originated by Ralph Hanna, a professional tier from Traverse City, Michigan. This pattern was created in the 1960's.
