

# Easy Hex



## Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 or #94833    Size: 2-6  
Thread: Yellow, 6/0  
Tail: Two stripped Ginger Hackle Stems, tied long, tied at a 75 degree angle.  
Body: Light Brown & Yellow dubbing, coarsely mixed.  
Hackle: Two Ginger and one Grizzly, mixed, tied heavy.

*Tying Tips:* Very easy to tie, a good pattern for a beginner. Any dubbing will work, either natural or poly. I've had excellent luck with rabbit fur.

*Fishing Tips:* Trim the hackle even with the hook point for dun imitations and further trim the hackle almost down to the shank for the spinner fall. Very effective during the 'hex hatch' on the South Branch of the Au Sable River.
