

Ephoron



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 14
Thread: White, 8/0
Tail: White Porcupine Guard Hairs, two,
tied long
Abdomen: White Thread
Wing: White Calf Body, tied post
Thorax: White Superfine Dubbing
Hackle: White, tied parachute

Tying Tips: Standard techniques. Tied delicate. The creator of this fly used a dubbing loop to form the thorax. I might suggest that this might also be tied in a #12 and #16.

Fishing Tips: Used for the *Ephoron* hatches that take place in Michigan in late August and September.

Historical Note: This fly was created by Al Rockwood of Muskegon, Michigan. It was most probably created in the late 70s or early 80s. The fly was designed to match the hatch on the Pigeon, Au Sable, White, Muskegon and Rogue River here in Michigan. Al was one of the founding members of the Muskegon-White River Chapter of TU.
