

# Giant Michigan Mayfly (Dun)



## Recipe

Hook:	Dry	Size: 2-6
Thread:	Yellow, 6/0	
Tail:	Two Pheasant Tail Fibers	
Wing:	Dark Elk or Deer hair, tied in a clump (post style).	
Body:	Natural deer hair tied parallel to the shank.	
Rib:	Yellow thread, tied crisscross.	
Hackle:	Brown & Grizzly mixed, tied parachute.	

*Tying Tips:* I use a Mustad #94840 or 94833. Please note, that the deer hair body is not flared at the tail.

*Fishing Tips:* Developed for the Hexagenia hatch. Place it right in the feeding lane.

*Historical Note:* Designer unknown. This fly pre-dates 1970.
