

Hanna's Brown Stone



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 12-14
Thread: Black, 8/0
Body: Redish/Brown Yarn
Body Wing: Natural Deer Hair, tied trude,
extended beyond the bend of the
hook.
Throat Wing: Brownish/Blackish Hen Hackle
Tips, tied swept back.
Hackle: Brown

Tying Tips: Standard techniques. This fly was also tied with a tan body. A good substitute for the throat wing described above would be a 'furnace' hen hackle.

Fishing Tips: Designed for the early brown stone hatch (*Brachyptera fasciata*). Used anytime mid-day when the hatch is going on.

Historical Note: This classic pattern was created by Ralph Hanna of Traverse City, Michigan back in the 1960's.
