

Hanna's White Miller



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 14
Thread: Black, 8/0
Tail: White Deer Hair
Body: White Yarn
Body Wing: White Deer Hair, tied trude,
extended beyond the bend of the
hook.
Throat Wing: White Hackle Tips, tied spent
Hackle: White

Tying Tips: Standard techniques. The creator of this fly always preferred to use deer hair from the forehead of an antlerless deer. It is much finer in texture than regular deer body hair.

Fishing Tips: Designed for the White Miller hatch (*Ephoron leukon*). Start fishing in the late evening and fish through into the dark.

Historical Note: Ralph Hanna is a professional tier from the Traverse City, Michigan area. He is still actively tying with over 60+ years of experience. He created this fly in the 1960's.
