

# Henwing Bomber



## Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 6-12  
Thread: Gray, 6/0  
Wing: Hen Grizzly Hackle Tips, tied  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  spent.  
Tail: Dun Mink Tail Guard Hairs  
Rib: Grizzly Hackle, palmered  
Body: Dyed Yellow Mink Fur &  
Gray/Brown Muskrat Fur,  
blended coarsely.  
Hackle: Grizzly & Brown, mixed

*Tying Tips:* I prefer a lighter hook #94833.

*Fishing Tips:* This fly was tied originally for *Acroneuria lycorias* and *Isoperla bilineate*. But, it's a good general purpose fly for stoneflies and caddis. It also works well for the hex hatch. I prefer to trim the hackles on the bottom when I fish with it.

*Historical Note:* This fly was co-created by Don Fox, a fly tyer from Chassell, Michigan and Jay Neve, a commercial tyer from Bellevue, Michigan.
