

Hex Fly

Recipe



Hook: Mustad Dry Fly Size: 8XL
Thread: Black, 6/0
Tail: Moose Body Hair, small clump
Body: Tan Wool Yarn
Wings: Grizzly Hackle Tips, tied spent, delta style
Hackle: Brown & Grizzly, mixed, one each

Tying Tips: Standard techniques.

Fishing Tips: Used for the *Hexagenia limbata* hatch.

Historical Note: Another pattern created by Leonard Halladay of Mayfield, Michigan. He created the Adams fly in 1922. This is one of Len's lesser known patterns. It appears with other family memorabilia in the permanent display at the library in Kingsley, Michigan. The fly is only available for examination through glass. I have reversed engineered it to the best of my ability. Len's original patterns were developed between 1920 and 1930.
