

Hill's Floater

Recipe



Hook: Mustad #94831 Size: 12-14
Thread: Black, 6/0
Tail: Red Hackle Fibers
Body: Bright Yellow Chenille
Rib: Grizzly Hackle, palmered

Tying Tips: Standard Techniques. The original was also tied with yellow thread.

Fishing Tips: An excellent attractor pattern. Might be used for the little yellow stone hatch if you wanted to tie it in smaller sizes. I strongly suspect this fly of being a good producer of bass and panfish. It is a great producer during late summer and early fall.

Historical Note: This fly was created by C.A. Hill of Gross Point, MI. It was originally tied for him by Paul Young (famous rod crafter of Detroit). Paul Young also sold these in his catalogues for many years. This fly was created sometime in the 1930's.
