

Hot Mustard

Recipe



Hook: Mustad #94840 Sz: 10-14
Thread: Black, 6/0
Body: Gold Antron Yarn, extended
beyond the bend of the hook.
Rib: Grizzly Hackle, palmered.

Tying Tips: No special techniques required.

Fishing Tips: This was designed for the Little Yellow Stone hatch here in Michigan. It was favored by the locals as a fly that could be fished from midsummer into late fall. It could also be fished during the Big Golden Stone hatch.

Historical Note: Josephine Sedlecky-Borsum was the owner of Ed's Sport Shop in Baldwin, Michigan, from 1945 till her retirement in 1992. She developed this pattern back in the early 1960's. The fly in this photograph, was actually tied by Josephine, and was donated by Mr. Douglas Loomis, the current owner of Ed's Sport Shop. The pattern information is correct and was supplied by Mr. David Roller who worked for Josephine from 1979 to 1986.
