

# Isonychia Spinner



## Recipe

Hook: Daiichi #1180 Size: 12  
Thread: Claret, 6/0  
Tail: 2 Moose Body Fibers, tied long.  
Body: Turkey Biot, dyed mahogany.  
Wing: Gray Z Lon or Poly Yarn, tied spent.  
Hackle: Cree or Brown & Grizzly, mixed.

*Tying Tips:* The biots have an edge that creates a segmented effect. Tie in the biot by the tip. Attach hackle pliers and wrap the body. If you don't see the segments forming properly, stop and re-attach the biot (opposite side). It just takes practice.

*Fishing Tips:* Used for the Maroon Drake hatch (*Isonychia sadleri*).

*Historical Note:* Mark Lord from Kingsley, Michigan created this pattern in 1998.
