

Jeff's Deer Hair Caddis

Recipe



Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 10-20
Thread: Tan or Light Olive, 6/0
Body: Brown Antron Body, or color to match the naturals
Wing: Deer Leg Hair
Head: Flared and clipped butts from the wing hair

Tying Tips: Standard techniques. Be sure you comb out the deer hair before tying it in. Tie and trim the head muddler style.

Fishing Tips: To be used anytime there are caddis on the river ... simply match the body color of the natural insects that are on the water.

Historical Note: This pattern originated from the vice of Jeff Bonin in 1990. Jeff hails from North Muskegon, Michigan where he is owner/operator of, 'Steelhead Connection Custom Flies.' "This pattern has out fished all other surface caddis patterns I have compared it to during my fishing on the Muskegon River over the past many years. It is simple, durable, and always produces fish."
