

Kelly's Hex



Recipe

- Hook: Mustad #94840 Sizes: 2-8 Long
Thread: Yellow, 6/0
Wing: White Calf Tail, tied post
Body: Died Yellow Moose Body Hair, tied in from behind the post and extending beyond the body. Wrap it to the rear of the body and extend the wrap ¼" beyond the hook bend.
Tail: Trim away extended moose body hairs leaving only a pair of tails in a V pattern.
Head: Tie in another clump of moose hair extending forward from the wing post. Wrap to the eye. Pull the moose hair back over itself and tie off right in front of the wing.
Legs: Pull a few hairs forward to give the impression of legs.

Tying Tips: No special tips needed.

Fishing Tips: Not only great for the hex hatch but it's a great night fishing that can be used during the entire season.

Historical Note: Developed by Kelly Galloup, a fly tier and river guide in the Traverse City, Michigan area. Kelly owned the Troutsman Fly Shop there. He developed this fly around 1981.
