Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Sz: 8-14

Thread: Black, 6/0

Body: Peacock Herl, tied heavy
Wing: Woodchuck, tied trude style

Hackle: Brown, tied heavy

Tying Tips: Beautifully simplistic, this pattern required no special tying instructions.

Fishing Tips: This pattern was developed as a generalized caddis attractor pattern. It can

literally be fished the entire season. I have been fishing this pattern since 1988.

It is my favorite 'go to' caddis pattern.

Historical Note: Josephine Sedlecky-Borsum was the owner of Ed's Sport Shop in Baldwin,

Michigan, from 1945 till her retirement in 1992. She developed this pattern back in the 1950's. While interviewing some of Jo's old friends I discovered that this is #1 in their entire arsenal of flies. The fly in this photograph, was actually tied by Josephine, and was donated by Mr. David Stewart. The pattern information is correct and was supplied by Mr. David Roller who worked for Josephine from

1979 to 1986.
