

Lacey Stephan



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #38941 or #94840	Size: 10
Thread:	Black, 6/0	
Body:	Deer Body Hair, tied on the shank of the hook. Hair should extend beyond the bend of the hook.	
Tail:	Tie off the extended Deer Body Hair tips, so that the hair spins.	
Wing:	Deer Body Hair, tied down over the back, trude style.	
Hackle:	Grizzly & Brown, mixed	

Tying Tips: May be tied in other sizes. White calf tail may be substituted for the wing.

Fishing Tips: Works any time of the day in any water, especially after the hex hatch has ended.

Historical Note: Lacey Stephan, Sr. (1909-1971) was a Au Sable boat builder, guide and fly-tier. In his later years he only fished with two flies, the Bicolored Walker and the fly presented here. Lacey actually called this fly the “Deer Hair Brown Hackle,” but most people now call it the Lacey Stephan.
