

Lacy's Caddis



Recipe

Hook: TMC 100 Size: 8-18
Thread: Brown, 8/0
Body: Light Orange Floss, rear 2/3 of the hook. Peacock Herl, front 1/3 of the hook.
Rib: Brown Hackle, palmered over the Floss.
Wing: Elk Hair, tied caddis style.
Head: Trimmed deer hair, caddis style

Tying Tips: Standard techniques.

Fishing Tips: This has been very successful when the October caddis are coming off, in the late season.

Historical Note: This fly was created in the 1990's by Jeff "Bear" Andrews of Grand Ledge, MI. Jeff has been fly fishing and fly tying since about 1970. He's a former shop owner and is very active in FFF. Jeff writes a monthly fly tying column for Michigan Out-of-Doors Magazine. Jeff named this fly after Lacy, a pretty little springer spaniel who used to be the shop mascot at The Great Lakes Flyfishing Company, in Rockford, MI.
