

Lady Bicolor Walker

Recipe



Hook: Mustad #94831 Size: 10-14 2XL-3XL
Thread: Black, 8/0
Tail: Pheasant Tail Fibers, tie in a 'V'
Egg Sac: Yellow Yarn tuft, extended beyond the bend of the hook
Body: Reddish/Brown Yarn
Body Wing: Brownish/Gray Deer Hair, tied trude, extended beyond the bend of the hook.
Throat Wing: White Hen Neck, tied spent
Hackle: Brown & Gray, mixed.

Tying Tips: Standard techniques. It may also be tied with a badger wing.

Fishing Tips: Used during the Brown Drake Hatch. Mr. Hanna prefers to use this fly just after dark.

Historical Note: Ralph developed this pattern in the late 1950's or early 1960's. Ralph also call this pattern the "Lady Brown Drake".
