

Madsen's Hex Spinner



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #9672 Size: 4-8
Thread: White, 3/0
Tail & Body: White Bucktail
Rib: White Hackle, palmered and trimmed.
Wings: 4 White Hen Feathers, quite wide and divided.
Hackle: White

Tying Tips: Wings are difficult to tie. Work the hackles in between the wings to help spread the wings, 2 forward and 2 rearward. Be generous with head cement.

Fishing Tips: White is highly visible. Use for night fishing when there is no moon. Used for The 'hex' hatch or any time for night fishing.

Historical Notes: This pattern was authored by Earl Madsen. Most of his creations were designed between the late 1930s and the early 1950s, which helps us to date this fly. I rarely see this fly in the shops anymore.
