

Mers' No-Hackle Hex



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #94840 Size: 6
Thread:	Tan, 6/0
Tail:	Extensions of the body hair, not flared.
Body:	Deer or elk body hair, tied parallel to the hook.
Rib:	Crisscrossed thread 4 to 5 turns.
Wing:	Black Tailed Deer, tied spent --- trim both sides to bring it to correct proportions.
Hackle:	None

Tying Tips: Simple and straight forward.

Fishing Tips: Designed for the hex hatch. The designer used Black Tailed Deer Hair because he believes that the color more perfectly matches the natural insect.

Historical Note: Created by Ken Mers of Coldwater, Michigan. Most probably a pattern of the mid- 1950's.
