

Michigan Caddis



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 or #94833 Size: 6-10
Thread: Black, 6/0
Tail: Natural Deer Hair
Body: Deer Hair, spun and shaped like an
'Irresistible.'
Hackle: Grizzly
Wing: Grizzly Hackle Tips, tied spent and
tied in front of the hackle.

Tying Tips: Deer hair spins better on a bare hook. Do not lay down a bed of thread.

Fishing Tips: Designed for the 'hex' hatch. Still a popular fly. Trim the hackle top and bottom so that the fly sits lower in the water.

Historical Note: Mr. Jay Neve claims Art Winnie as the originator of this fly. There is no evidence to support that. According to his daughter Jeanne this is not the caddis pattern that Art is famous for. Most probably Art Winnie did tie and sell these from his barber shop.
