

Michigan Caddis II



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #94831 Size: 6 XL
Thread:	Black, 6/0
Tail:	Two Moose Main Hairs, tied in a V at 45 degrees.
Wing:	White Deer Body Hair, tied
Underbody:	Dyed Yellow Deer Hair
Overbody:	Natural Deer Hair
Hackle:	Grizzly & Brown, mixed, tied parachute.

Tying Tips: Tie in the yellow deer body hair and wrap forward 2/3 hook shank. Tie in the natural deer overbody and wrap the thread, palmering back toward the hook bend. Flare the hair with a couple of wraps and wind it forward in a crisscross pattern. Wing post can be tied in before or after you tie in the body hair.

Fishing Tips: Designed for the hex hatch. Extremely productive and a good floater.

Historical Note: This fly was created and tied by Bill Koernke of Grayling, Michigan. He was a tier and the owner of Bill's Fly Shop back in the 1980's and 1990's. His shop was located on Lovells Road just south of County Road 612. Request for additional information on Bill and his recipes have not been acknowledged by his family. The recipe was reconstructed by reverse engineering, under a microscope.
