

# Michigan May Fly



## Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 or #94833 Size: 10  
Thread: Brown, 6/0  
Tail: Wood-duck Flank, trimmed quill  
Wing: Light Blue Dun Hackle Tips  
Body: Gray Fur Dubbing  
Hackle: Ginger & Grizzly, mixed, tied parachute

*Tying Tips:* Extremely difficult fly to tie --- but very interesting. This is a parachute pattern --- but there is no upright post to wrap around.

*Fishing Tips:* A generalized pattern used for dark mayfly hatches.

*Historical Note:* Regretfully, the tier of this beautiful and delicate fly is unknown. The only historical source I could find for this pattern is "Modern Dry Flies," (Jorgensen, 1975). I'm sure this fly pre-dates 1970.
