

# Michigan Spinner



## Recipe

Hook:	Dry	Size:	2-10
Thread:	White, 6/0		
Tail:	Two Pheasant Tail Fibers, tied long.		
Wing:	White Bucktail, tied upright & divided.		
Rib:	Light Brown Cotton Thread		
Body:	Cream Red Fox Fur and Yellow Wool Dubbing, mixed.		
Hackle:	Grizzly & Ginger, mixed.		

*Tying Tips:* Pretty straight forward pattern to tie. Tie in the rib cotton thread at the bend of hook before you wrap your dubbing.

*Fishing Tips:* Designed for the Michigan 'hex' hatch (*Hexagenia limbata*).

*Historical Note:* This fly pre-dates 1950. The tyer is unknown. This beautiful pattern has not been seen in the shops for many years. The original thread was probably silk. It has also been tied with black thread. The rib has also been tied with light brown floss.

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
