Moose Hair Caddis



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 10-12

Thread: Black, 6/0

Body: Bleached Moose Hair, tied parallel

to the hook shank, extended body

style.

Wing: Grizzly Hackle Tips, paired and

tied spent.

Rib: Crisscrossed thread.

Tail: Moose Hair, extended from the

body, clipped away leaving only a

few strands for the tail.

Hackle: Ginger

Tying Tips: Standard techniques.

Fishing Tips: A generalized pattern that could be used any time there were light colored

drakes or spinners on the water.

Historical Note: This fly was created by Clarence Roberts back in the 1950s. He was a

Michigan game warden from 1942 to 1971. He was tying flies commercially

from 1949 until his retirement.
