

Peacock Bumble



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #94840 Size: 8-12
Thread:	Black, 6/0
Abdomen:	Deer Hair, dyed black, spun, packed and trimmed, extended beyond the shank of the hook
Wing:	Deer Hair, dyed yellow, spun, packed and trimmed, extended to the bend of the hook
Thorax:	Deer Hair, dyed yellow, spun, packed and trimmed short
Head:	Peacock Herl

Tying Tips: When tying in the abdomen, taper the body so that when you spin in the wing and thorax, the wing hairs will lay down over the back of the body. The most popular size is #10

Fishing Tips: Fish late August through November or until the first frost(s) come.
