

# Ralph's Deer Hair Drake



## Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 14 XL  
Thread: Black, 8/0  
Tail: Pheasant Tail Fibers, tied in a 'V'  
Wing: White Deer Hair, tied clump style  
Body: Tan Deer Hair, tied parallel to the hook, flared at the tail.  
Rib: Black thread, tied crisscross  
Hackle: Grizzly

*Tying Tips:* Standard techniques. Tied drake style. The fly may be tied in different sizes.

*Fishing Tips:* A generalized attractor pattern that can be used most any time.

*Historical Note:* This fly was originated by Ralph Hanna, a professional tyer from Traverse City, Michigan. This pattern was created in the 1960's. Ralph was a commercial tier for Herter's, and is still tying today.
