Regan's Black Caddis



Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: #18

Thread: Black, 6/0

Body: Black Thread, tied full length of the

shank.

Wing: Dark Deer Hair, tied down wing, then

pull the butt ends up to form the post

for the parachute tie.

Hackle: Brown & Grizzly mixed, tied parachute,

trim off the post.

Tying Tips: The pattern pictured is a female. The only adjustment to your pattern is that you

tie in a Lime Green Yarn Egg Sac, cut short. Jerry prefers the deer hair from the

back of a mid-October killed deer. Some fishermen tie this in a size #16.

Fishing Tips: Fished during the "Chimarra" hatches from late April through August.

Historical Note: Jerry Regan is the acknowledged expert on 'old' Michigan Flies. He is a third

generation tier who ties both commercially and professionally. He created this

pattern around 1990.
