

Regan's Hex



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad #9672 or #9671	Sizes: 6-8
Thread:	Yellow, 3/0	
Tail:	Pheasant Tail Fibers (several)	
Body:	Deer Hair, tie hair parallel to hook, pull butt ends of deer hair up 90 degrees to form post, wind thread around the base of the post.	
Hackle:	Two brown hackles, tied in parallel to the hook at the base of post.	
Wings:	Dun Hen Neck, tied in spent.	

Tying Tips: It is very important to tie the hackles in before you tie on the wings. If you tie in the wings before you place the hackle in place it makes a mess, if you get this out of sequence you will see what I mean.

Fishing Tips: A tremendous pattern, especially on the South Branch during the hex hatch.

Historical Note: Jerry is a third generation tier, originally born in Grayling, Michigan.
