

Rivergod Emerger



Recipe

- Hook: TMC #100 (Sz. 12-20), TMC #2488 (Sz. 22-24)
Thread: 8/0 to match the natural insect
Tail: Wood Duck Flank Fibers
Shuck: Hi-Viz Wing Material, 2/3 length of the tail (hook #20 and smaller, no shuck).
Body: Natural or Synthetic Dubbing, to match the natural insect.
Wing: Dark Dun Crinkled Z-Lon

Tying Tips: Hooks #16 and smaller, use a thread body with a dubbed thorax with one turn of dubbing behind the wing and the remainder in front of the wing.

Fishing Tips: This mayfly emerger pattern can be used for many hatches; simply adjust the size, color of the dubbing and color of the thread.

Historical Note: This pattern was created by Dennis Potter, of Grand Rapids, Michigan around 1985. The above photograph is of a Sulphur, Pale Morning Dun (PMD).
