Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94840 Size: 12

Thread: Black, 6/0 Tail: Woodchuck

Wing: Grizzly, tied spent Rib: Yellow Monochord Body: Dark Olive Floss

Hackle: Brown

Tying Tips: Standard techniques.

Fishing Tips: This fly works well during the brown drake hatch during late May and June.

Historical Note: Another pattern created by Clarence Roberts of Michigan back in the 1950s.

It has been reported that Clarence knew a Seth Green who was a Conservation Officer in Michigan. The DNR and the Roberts' family deny this. Most likely, Clarence was familiar with the famous 'Seth Green' fly pattern designed by the famous Mr. Seth Green of New York, who was a famous fly tyer and fish culturist. The idea for Clarence's creation most probably came from the original. An original, tied by Clarence is on display at the Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center, in Roscommon, Michigan. There are several other patterns

with this same name.
