

Spent Poly Winged Caddis

Recipe



Hook: TMC 100 Size: 16-20
Thread: Green, 6/0
Body: Green Super Fine Dubbing
Wing: Light Dun Poly Yarn splayed into
two sets of wings.

Tying Tips: Easy to tie up. The body can be any color to match the naturals.
Thread should match the body color.

Fishing Tips: I tie this fly in about 6 different colors to match the local hatches. It can be fished any time from May through October when there are small adult insects on the water. I use it for Ephemerella, Chimarra and Alloperla genera.

Historical Note: Michigan will lay claim to this fly even though we do not know who the creator is. This fly has been used on our waters for many years ... and I have never seen it anywhere else. It is popular enough that it can be found in some Michigan fly shops. It dates back to the early 1990s.
