

Streamside Mahogany



Recipe

Hook: Orvis #1523 Size: 12
Thread: Gray, 6/0
Tail: Dark Brown Fine Elk Hock,
or Yearling Elk
Post: Dun Colored Calf Body or
Calftail or Gray Poly Yarn
Body: Claret or Wine Colored dyed
Deer Hair, flared at the bend of
the hook.
Rib: Crisscrossed thread.
Hackle: Grizzly, tied parachute

Tying Tips: Standard techniques used for a parachute drake pattern. Mark dyed his deer hair with 'Wine' colored Rit Dye.

Fishing Tips: Used for the *Isonychia* hatches (both of them).

Historical Notes: This fly was created by Mark Lord of Kingsley, Michigan. Mark created this pattern back in 1996. He named the fly after the Streamside Orvis Shop, in Traverse City, where he worked and tied flies for.
