

Tim's Brown Drake



Recipe

Hook: Tiemco #100 Size: 12
Thread: Black, 6/0 unwaxed
Tail: Ox Hair, two hairs, tied long, tied in a 'v'
Body: Black Coastal Deer Hair, tied drake style, flared at the bend of the hook
Post: White Polypropylene Yarn
Hackle: Brown Saddle Hackle, tied parachute

Tying Tips: No special techniques needed. The author of the fly never specified what type of Ox hair. Based on the color and length I believe it to be Musk Ox, body hair. He also states Black Coastal Deer Hair, but does not indicate natural or dyed. For the fly above I used 'natural dark' coastal deer.

Fishing Tips: Designed to be used for the Brown Drake Hatch but is a good effective fly anytime there are dark insects on the water.

Historical Note: Designed by Tim Simons of Michigan. I have not been able to find any specific information about Tim. This fly was created by Tim sometime around the year 2000.
