

# Yellow Palmered Caddis



## Recipe

Hook: Mustad #94831 2XL Sz: 6-10  
Thread: Yellow, 6/0  
Tail: Pheasant Tail Fibers, small clump  
Body: Yellow Wool, tied with loop (egg sac)  
Rib: Brown Hackle, palmered heavy  
Wing: Grizzly Hackle Tips, paired, tied spent  
Hackle: Brown

*Tying Tips:* Standard techniques.

*Fishing Tips:* Used during the golden drake hatch and/or the big golden stone hatch.

*Historical Note:* Clarence Roberts was a game warden and commercial tier back in the 40s, 50s and 60s. This fly was originated by Clarence back in the 1950s. This fly is also called the Yellow Caddis or the Palmered Tied Yellow Caddis. This pattern, tied by Clarence is on display at the DNR Ralph A. MacMullen Conference Center in Roscommon, Michigan.
